Sydney Dance Company has returned to Australia from a critically acclaimed sell-out French tour, which included a 2-week residency at the renowned Théâtre National de Chaillot in Paris.

ab [intra]'s Sydney season will see one of Rafael Bonachela's most career-defining works return to the Roslyn Packer Theatre in Walsh Bay for a limited time. It will also be the final time that audiences will be able to see senior dancer Davide di Giovanni performing on stage before he steps away from the ensemble after 7 years with the Company.

Rafael Bonachela's award-winning work ab [intra] returns to Sydney for an encore season showcasing Australia's premiere contemporary dancers.

ab [intra], meaning 'from within' in Latin is 'an exploration of our primal instincts, our impulses and our visceral responses', says choreographer Rafael Bonachela.

The music fuses lush cello with ambient electronica while the dancers occupy a visually arresting ethereal world.
